

1 Important Information Before You Install

The ThermaTouch Control must be installed inside the shower. The ThermaTouch control will only function on the current TFX and PRO Series generators.


Ensure there is a 3.5-inch clearance on all sides of the mud ring to prevent any interference with fixtures or wall corners during the mounting of the control.

The control should be installed 60" from the floor of the shower and away from the steamhead.

The steamhead should be installed 24" from the floor and 6" from any wall. Locate as far as possible from the bathing seating area or location of the users and not below any fixtures.


IMPORTANT: When locating and installing the ThermaTouch, it is required to not place the control under any water-outlets, shower heads or in the direct path of flowing water.

SEE DIAGRAM FOR LOCATION EXAMPLE.



Your Smart PDM comes with a preinstalled grounding lug. Prior to installation of your ThermaTouch and Smart PDM, locate the closest earth ground (electrical outlet, copper water pipe) and attach a grounding wire as shown. Grounding wire not included.



3 Mud Ring Application








4 Control Installation and Data Cable Connection

Route the cable harness through the finished wall to the back side of the control. (The other end of the cable runs to the Smart PDM location.)


NOTE: Avoid tight bends. DO NOT pinch, nail, staple, wedge or bind the cable harness.

Run the cable harness through the mud ring as shown in the diagram and connect the water resistant data and video to the leads coming out of the control screen.

4 Control Installation and Data Cable Connection

Connect the data, video and ethernet cables from the provided cable harness to Smart Power Distribution Module (Smart PDM).

The other end of the cable runs to the back of the control in the shower location.

WARNING: The data line is NOT a standard USB cable. It carries 24V power and the use of standard cables can result in damage to the unit. USE ONLY Thermasol Cable Harness (P/N 10-8232) to connect the PDM and display.


DO NOT pinch, nail, staple, wedge, or bind the cable harness.

DO NOT attempt to shorten the cable harness.

DO NOT wrap the cable harness around steam line or route it in a manner so that the hot steam line could melt the cable.

Any damage to the cable harness will result in the control not working properly.

Carefully connect the cable harness to the Smart PDM and control BEFORE turning power on to the generator or Smart PDM.






5 Connecting Smart PDM to Generator and Accessories

All external devices are connected to the ThermaTouch control via the Smart PDM. The Smart PDM is equipped with two identical M8 connections and one M12 connection.

To connect the steam generator, utilize one of the M8 ports. The remaining M8 port is available for linking additional ThermaSol shower accessories, such as a Digital Shower Valve. The M12 port is designated for

connecting a powered rainhead, such as ThermaSol's HydroVive or Serenity.

IMPORTANT: If neither the HydroVive nor Serenity rainhead option is utilized, amplified speakers are necessary for sound. These can be connected to the Smart PDM via the 3.5mm Audio port on the back of the unit.





6 Sealing Control


THESE STEPS MUST BE TAKEN FOR CORRECT INSTALLATION OF THE CONTROL. BEFORE MAKING FINAL CABLE CONNECTIONS TO THE THERMATOUCH CONTROL. TEST THAT ALL CONNECTIONS ARE WORKING BEFORE SEALING THE CONTROL TO THE WALL. ENSURE THE ORIENTATION LABEL ON THE FACE OF THE CONTROL IS POINTING UP. (Power on the control and see that it lights up, and is oriented correct).



Following the groove on back of the control, fill with the supplied silicone ensuring there is enough silicone in the groove to seal to the wall material. (Minimum 1/8" out of groove)

Once in place, completely seal the outer edge of the control to the wall so moisture does not collect behind it. wipe away any excess silicone.

Place the control on the wall pressing firmly. You may need to tape the control into place until the silicone dries. Be careful not to harm the wall or control with the tape. Let dry for 24 hours before using steam bath.





7 Steam Line and Steamhead

Now you will need to decide on the steamhead placement in the shower so you can run the steam line from the generator to the steamhead. There are a couple of things you need to know about the placement of the steamhead and steam line itself.

DO NOT install any valve in the steam line. Flow of steam must be unobstructed.


DO NOT plumb any traps in the steam line.

- A The water inlet on the generator requires a 1/2" brass union for easy installation.
- B Use 1/2" brass pipe or copper tubing from unit to steamhead rough-in fitting as permitted by codes. materials that may be in the water inlet line.
- C See next page.

The steam line can run up and then down, once; or horizontal; but never run down and then up. If it does, a steam trap will be produced at the low point blocking the flow of steam.

Insulate the steam outlet piping if the piping run exceeds 10 feet or is exposed to cold areas. Use steam rated insulation.

Pitch/angle steam lines back towards generator before any up or down turns; pitch/angle towards steam room after any up or down and avoid perfectly level plumbed lines. This prevents condensation from pooling at low points in the steamline.





7 Steam Line and Steamhead

DO NOT install the steamhead near the seating area or the user.

C Ins

Install the steamhead 24" from the floor or bathtub rim and 6" from any corner.

Steamhead is to be mounted as far as possible from typical bathing position (seated or standing) and installed as far from the in-shower controller as possible.

For retrofit to existing finish wall:


Drill a 1-1/8" diameter hole in the shower wall or wall above bathtub rim for the steam outlet rough-in fitting and install to be flush with the finished wall. this housing must be sealed to the wall to not allow vapor or water behind it. (plumbing must be done from backside of finshed space)

For new framing: Mount and install rough-in fitting to be flush with finished wall.

Connect a 1/2" NPT brass pipe or copper tubing to the steam outlet union (not included) on the generator running the pipe to the steam head location in the wall to connect with the steamhead rough-in fitting. It is very important that the pipe is firmly secured to the wall, so that when the steamhead is installed it doesn't push the rough-in fitting back into the wall. Install a 1/2" dropear elbow on the end of the 1/2" pipe or tubing for the rough-in fitting.

Use the installation tool to tighten the housing in place with a 1" socket and driver. Then insert the protective cap into the housing.

For all the connections, use solder for copper joints and Teflon tape for pipe fittings and do not over tighten fittings. **DO NOT USE PVC CEMENT.**






7 Steam Line and Steamhead

Once the shower wall is complete and the housing is sealed to the wall, remove the protective cap and insert the steamhead into housing. Use the supplied silicone to adherethe steamhead to the wall sealing out any water from getting behind the head.

Use supplied o-ring lubricant to assist in steam head installation. A very small amount is all that is need directly on the o-rings.



8 Final Pre-Check Before Operation

Turn ON the water supply to the generator. Check all the connections for leaks.

Plug in generator (unless hardwired model).

Turn ON the power source or breaker.

Verify control panel lights up and test operation. Note: Initial power-on phase takes several minutes for generator to heat up steam.








3 Typical System Layout




DIGITAL SHOWER VALVE

Multiple components from one port location







(Fig. 1) Installation Profile View




Placement and Cutout


Cut a 16.7" square out of your ceiling and frame it in.


Once framed in, you'll want a minimum clearance of 14.45" x 14.25" for comfortable installation. Framing studs should be on 16" Centers.

Put all your connections through the hole as the rest of the installation will be completed from inside the shower.

NOTE: HydroVive weighs 37 lbs. It must be mounted to a framed structure that can support its weight.







Digital Shower Valve By adding the Digital Shower Valve, you replace multiple manual valves and can control all shower functions through a single ThermaTouch Control.




Mounting Brackets

Measure and locate the midpoints on each 14.25" side of the cutout. The midpoints are where you'll install the mounting brackets, each mounting bracket will require 4-3/4" (included) wood screws.

WARNING: READ BEFORE PROCEEDING:

The HydroVive weighs 37 lbs. and overhead lifting is required to continue installation. Please be cautious and practice ladder safety.




5 Connecting HydroVive

NOTE: Make sure electrical power is off to all ThermaSol devices prior to making any connections.

Align the notches at the top of the mounting guides with the mounting brackets and slip them over to firmly secure the HydroVive in place while the connections are made. With HydroVive secured on the mounting brackets, angle the unit to gain access and connect all cables.

Double check to ensure that all connections are correct before moving forward.





6 Connecting to Power Distribution Module (PDM)

Connect both the M12 power/data cable from the rainhead and the M12 cable from ThermaTouch to the PDM

Plug the PDM into a standard 110VAC outlet, test at the control that all functions are working prior to moving forward.









7 Sealing HydroVive

Apply silicone along the groove on the back of HydroVive.



8 Move Into Place


Guide the HydroVive into the ceiling and rest it on the highest hook you can reach. Use the 3.5" included mounting screws, and gradually insert them a little at a time to evenly lift the HydroVive into position to create a seal with the previously applied silicone. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN! Once the HydroVive is in position and the silicone seal is created, no further clamping force is necessary.



Complete Installation

Install the Screw Covers with O-Rings by hand.

Allow the silicone to dry for 24 hours before use.
